

Accommodations

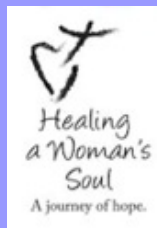
Our host, the Dominican Retreat Center, is located 1945 Union St. (Rt. 7) in Niskayuna, NY. It is a smoke-free, alcohol-free, and scent-free facility with private bedrooms and shared bathrooms. There are spacious grounds for walking, a library and chapel. The entire facility is handicapped accessible. Parking is available in front of the Retreat House.

Arrival Registration with light refreshments begins at 6:30 pm on Friday, September 6.
